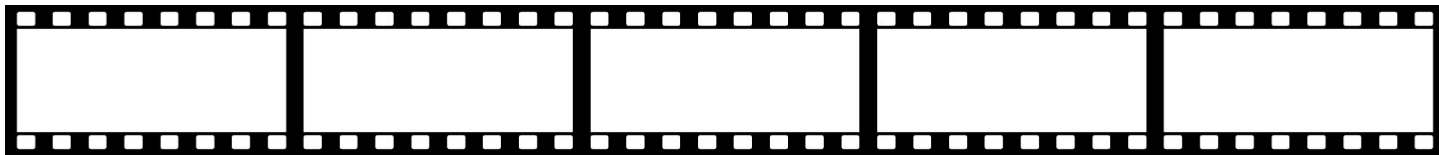
Identify and describe 5 major events from your story that you would be sure to bring to the big screen. Describe the challenges you would face in adapting each event.
